45th Anniversary Fact Sheet

Who: For nearly five decades, Sierra Club's Michigan Chapter has organized the bold action of citizens to protect and restore our state's natural heritage. **We're 25,000 members and supporters strong**, and we're led by volunteers – people just like you. Our nine Sierra Club Groups work on a variety of local issues, and statewide the Chapter works with volunteer leaders, state agencies and the legislature for better stewardship of our natural resources.

What: Together over the years, our staff and volunteers have accomplished many things, such as:

- Cleaned up toxic air pollution from incinerators and water pollution from factory farms.
- Helped stop Great Lakes oil and gas drilling and protected them from water diversions.
- Blocked more than 100 damaging oil and gas leases throughout the state.
- Convinced legislators to enact renewable energy and energy efficiency requirements.
- Helped apply pressure on Consumers Energy until it abandoned proposed Bay City power plant.

What?! Did you know the Sierra Club is the key reason these natural treasures are protected?

- Sleeping Bear Dunes National Lakeshore and Grand Island National Recreation Area
- A pristine coastline at Pictured Rocks National Lakeshore, unmarred by a road
- 90,000 acres of old-growth forests protected by the Michigan Wilderness Heritage Act

How: **We raise awareness** about environmental and health threats and monitor water quality to aid enforcement efforts. **We build coalitions** to diversify support and address the interconnected nature of environmental, economic and social issues. **We find sensible policy solutions** to our state's problems. **We lobby** on critical issues and report back on lawmakers' actions. **We rally** voters and help elect pro-environment leaders. **We fight** for environmental democracy. **We take legal action** to stop corporate interests and government from hurting public health and natural resources.
