

## Requests and Requirements for Useful Photography Grand River Expedition 2010

With your digital camera, you can help photo-document the GRE. To help in this project, please read the following instructions: Thanks!

- Digital media is the best and easiest way to share images
- The purpose of photos and documentations:
  - To document events, participants, and locations for GRE 2010
  - To gather photos for a short educational media documentary
  - To be used for memories and promotions.
- Camera Requested Set-Ups
  - Use memory cards with camera instead of internal memory
    - Ie. SD, Compact Flash, Memory Stick, etc
    - Can be removed from camera and downloaded on laptop
    - No cables necessary
  - Set up to take .jpeg images, not "raw" images
  - Utilize larger format images - greater than 1000k/images
    - Larger is better for projection
    - Storage is no longer a problem
    - With larger images we can crop and/or downsize images
  - Set up camera with no date stamp on photos
    - Date stamp cannot be removed from image
    - Can be distracting and interfere with desired image
  - Set current date on camera for chronology documentation
    - This helps with sorting of photos in groups
    - Allows for proper chronology of events
  - Take lots of pictures:
    - With lots of pictures, you are more likely to have a few great shots.
    - Many photographers gives a more diverse perspective
  - What kind of pictures to take ?
    - People paddling, wildlife, interesting scenery, river oddities
    - Events, campsites, portages, helpers
  - When will we collect images ?
    - Every few evenings when the day's paddle is done.
    - We will attempt to keep individuals' photos separated and identified
